This award is presented each year to one of our Allied Trades friends for their support and involvement in the Texas Branch of AALAS. The Awards Committee is responsible for judging and selection of the Helen Jordan Vendor's Award sponsored by Charles A. Montgomery, Jr. Family. The name and the nomination packet of the recipient are forwarded to a representative selected by Charles Montgomery for presentation of a plaque each year at the TBAALAS annual meeting. To qualify, a candidate must be a TBAALAS commercial member for the past 5 years and nominated by a TBAALAS member. This award recognizes individuals who have through their support advanced the TBAALAS goals and purposes of continuing education, training and knowledge exchange. An individual may achieve this award only once.
